Organisation

Main purpose of job

The Team Leader is responsible for the overall strategic leadership, managerial oversight and technical direction of the programme. He/she leads a team of technical experts and administrators and also serves as the key point of contact for the World Bank, government, programme consortium partners, and other stakeholders. The Team Leader will report to the Country Representative based in the Options Nairobi office and work closely with Options' management and administrative colleagues. Coordinating the inputs of a team of technical experts from Options and partners, s/he will ensure that programme objectives, outcomes, and deliverables are met and that financial, operational, and reporting requirements of the donor are adhered to.

Responsibilities will include:

- Programme delivery, and oversight oversee programme strategies, technical approaches, workplans, risk management, and budgets. Ensure the programme delivers against its theory of change and achieves its intended results.
- Team management and leadership lead a team of technical, financial and administrative experts to deliver the programme to the highest technical quality.
- Client, government and partner relations be the primary liaison with the donor, represent the programme on behalf of Options and ensure close collaboration with relevant local, national and international stakeholders. Also, take a leading role in disseminating successes and lessons from the project across all stakeholders.

Main duties

To be successful in this role you will possess:

- Extensive experience providing technical, strategic and management oversight to large donor funded health programmes and/or organizations. Specifically, expertise and experience of working in Kenya's health sector, with in-depth knowledge of health systems strengthening approaches in the context of devolution; Kenya's planning, budgeting, monitoring and reporting cycle and its current challenges and opportunities; and principles of public financial management and evidence-informed decision-making.
- Experience providing capacity building support to key decision-makers around planning, budgeting, monitoring and use of data for decision making.
- Significant experience and a track record of successful leadership and management of teams based in multiple locations. Previous experience leading a large team of highly skilled, multidisciplinary staff to leverage joint management support, and empowering team members to deliver high quality work.
- Strong external liaison and negotiation skills with experience of fostering partnerships between Government and other stakeholders, including at county level, to improve health system performance, and build national and sub-national capacity. Familiarity with government practice and protocol.
- Demonstrable experience of working with the World Bank and familiarity of World Bank practice and protocol with a proven ability to represent organisations and programmes with the World Bank.
- Experience engaging closely with and/or managing partner organizations, including consortium management (desirable).
- Experience of managing contracts (including payment by results desirable) and contracting; excellent financial management skills.
- A postgraduate qualification in public health, or related discipline.
- Excellent written and spoken English is essential.
